Opportunity Rising Summit Scholarship Application

The Summit Scholarship Award is for college students who are returning to school after a separation of at least two years, to help off-set some of the cost of the student's education.

Summit eligibility requirements are:

- · Student must reside in DHA supported housing
- · Student must attend a two (2) hour "Getting Started Again" workshop
- · Student must apply for financial aid
- · Student must show proof of paid application/registration fee
- · Must complete this application

To apply for this scholarship, students submit the following:

- · Proof of registration (i.e. class schedule, fee receipt or letter from institution)
- · Address & telephone number of the institution of higher learning
- · Student's address & telephone number on campus
- Submit a typed 300-word essay on: "Why it is Important for Me to Pursue a Higher Education." (no longer than 550 words)

Each Essay will be judged on:

- Quality of content
- · Ability to captivate the reader
- Originality
- Correct grammar usage (punctuation and spelling)
- · Overall presentation
